FRIDAY NIGHT PULL, August 21st

Registration and weigh-in will start at 4:00 p.m. Pull will begin at 6:00 p.m. Classes pulling Friday night Include:

- **Antique 3200, 4200, 5200, 6500**
- **Classic 2600, 3200, 4200**
- **Powder Puff 4200**
- **King of the Hill 4200 (first place trophy only)**

SATURDAY NIGHT PULL, August 22nd

Registration and weigh-in will start at 4:00 p.m. Pull will begin at 5:00 p.m. Classes pulling Saturday night include:

- **Classic 5200, 6500, 7500, 8500, 10000**
- **King of the Hill 5200, 6500 (first place trophy only)**

\$20 entry fee per tractor/per weight class.

Antique class includes tractors **through the year of 1939.**

Classic class includes tractors **through the year of 1969.**

Powder Puff and King of the Hill classes will be antique and classic combined.

Tractor Pull Rules and Regulations

1. **# OF HOOKS:** Each tractor registered in the pull can pull 1 time per weight class and a maximum of 2 antique or classic pulls each night. Tractors need only to qualify as an antique or classic tractor to be allowed to pull in the king of the hill classes. The king of the hill classes and the powder puff class will not be counted against your maximum pulls. This means a tractor could pull up to 4 times each night. One restart will be allowed per pull. (Has to be less than 75 feet.)
2. **SPEED:** Maximum speed limit of **3.5 MPH** on Friday night and **4 MPH** on Saturday night. King of the Hill classes will have no speed limit.
3. **RPM'S:** Working governors are required. Governors must maintain no more than 10% over stock RPM's. Judges will test tractors if necessary. Judges will make the final decision. King of the hill classes may pull in any gear and use any RPM.
4. **WEIGHT:** All tractors must be weighed first at lowest weight class pulling and immediately before they pull. There is no over weight allowance. 4200 means a maximum of 4200.
5. **HITCHES:** Drawbar length must be a minimum of 18 inches from center of axle to pulling point. Maximum of 20 inches high at pulling point. Pull hitch with a 3" opening or a clevis is required. Vertical hitches will be measured to pulling point determined by judges. Hook chain must not touch any other part of tractor. (No hooking over a drawbar)
6. **TIRES:** No tractors with cut tires, duals, or 4-wheel drive allowed.
7. **TURBOS:** Turbos are not allowed.
8. **TORQUE CONVERTER:** Any tractor manufactured with a torque converter (i.e., TA on a Farmall) is allowed to use the torque converter once per hook.
9. **SAFETY:** All drivers must attend the driver's safety meeting that will be held before the tractor pull starts. Drivers must be 18 years of age or parental approval is required. King of the hill drivers must be 18 years of age or older. No drinking of alcohol before or during the pull or drivers will be disqualified. When hooking up to the sled, tractor must be in neutral and the driver's foot must be off the clutch. All drivers must stay on tractor seat during their pull. Kill switches (brake away switches) are suggested. Any piece, part or weight that falls off of tractor during its pull will result in immediate disqualification.
10. Side panels on any tractors in the pull must be available to be opened.
11. **NO REFUND** of registration fee if Puller is disqualified.
12. Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated.
13. **All judges decisions are FINAL.**
